BEST PRACTICE 1:

HELPING OUT THE NEEDY:

- Our college caters to the students from border areas, many students come from marginalized families who cannot pay their fees and buy books. College staff is always helpful towards such students. Voluntary contribution is made every year by teaching staff towards common pool or at individual level, at the time of admissions and fee payment.
- In addition to College library, institution has a book-bank which issues books to the needy for the entire semester. Also, teachers have their own individual collection of books in every department. Students borrow these books and return at the end of the session, and the same books are used by students from next batch.
- **Recently, our dept of Chemistry has initiated LMS MOODLE Myeclass. Self-recorded Video lectures on full syllabus of BSc 1st year and Inorganic Chemistry (2nd year) are uploaded by the subject teacher. Students can access any topic, anytime and any number of times. This facility is provided with no extra cost. Gradually, this facility will be extended to other classes as well. The Institution is on the track to follow Flipped Classroom model of Teaching and learning.**

BEST PRACTICE 2:

1. ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN AWARENESS AMONG MASSES: College staff and NSS/NCC volunteers participate actively in campaigns of Awareness among masses, both in and out of the college campus, about various issues like Female foeticide, menace of Dowry, Gender bias, AIDS, Thalassemia, etc. Our teams did a commendable job in spreading awareness about Covid-19.
